TODAY is the **THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT**, the season consisting of the forty days and six Sundays before Easter as we journey through the desert with Christ to the font of our rebirth. The liturgy takes on a simpler tone and the liturgical colour is purple to reflect the spirit of penitence and renewal. The word 'Alleluia' disappears from the vocabulary of worship until Easter as does the Gloria. No incense is used during this season.
