If no clergy cover is available:

Use the orders of service as printed.

The Pastoral Musician with members of the Vestry will appoint one or two leaders to lead the service. If there are two leaders, Leader A can be one of the readers on the rota and Leader B can be the intercessor on the rota. If there is one service leader, that person should not also be reader or intercessor on that day. A leader with ministerial experience can adapt the following arrangements at their discretion.
